

Notification of interest in a premises Licensing Act 2003

Any person or organisation with a legal or financial interest in a property may give notice to the licensing authority of their interest, in order to be kept informed of any licensing applications which relate directly to that property.

Under the 2003 Act, persons with a legal or financial interest in a property are defined as:

- the freeholder or leaseholder of the premises;
- a legal mortgagee in respect of the premises; or
- a person who is in occupation of the premises.

There is no legal requirement for persons with these property interests to give notice to the licensing authority – it is entirely at their discretion as to whether to make use of this provision. However the licensing authority has no legal duty to notify any such interested persons of relevant licence applications if they have not given notice of their interest in accordance with these provisions.

Notices may be given in respect of any property or piece of land within the borough, regardless of whether there is currently a licence in force or not.

Giving notification of your interest in a premises

Fees can be paid by cheque/postal order (payable to 'Dacorum Borough Council') or credit/debit card <u>only</u>. Please do not send cash.

Once received, the authority will record your interest in the premises, endorse the notice and return it to you. You will then be formally notified of any subsequent applications relating to licences under the Licensing Act 2003, in respect of the premises indicated. This may include new applications, variations of existing licences, transfers, reviews, or notification if the licence lapses or is surrendered.

The notice of interest is valid for 12 months from the date of receipt. After this time, if you still wish to be kept informed of any applications or changes made for licences in respect of the premises, you may submit a new notice.
